### WHAT IS THE FUNCTION OF THIS ROLE?

#### ROLE SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Site Manager, this role is a 'hands-on' role requiring the daily operation of composting technology, plant and machinery within the In-Vessel Composting (IVC) Site. You will be processing co-mingled food and green waste, creating desirable quality compost which benefits the agricultural sector and diverts waste from landfill. The site can process up to 35,000 tonnes of organic waste per year.

This full-time role will be based from Ardley IVC Site, near Bicester in Oxfordshire. The core hours are 07.00 – 17.00 Monday – Friday, with weekends and bank holidays on rota basis. There will be occasions where you will be called upon to work and support other site (s) within the region as requested by management.

Working within a team of 5, this hands-on varied role requires a flexible approach to work and a desire to be part of a team that takes pride in their work.
